



## Hardware and Software Guidelines for Rapattoni Hosted Systems

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Rapattoni hosted Magic 10 represents a shift in technology as the industry moves toward a cloud-based model. Since Magic 10 is hosted in the cloud, you no longer need to purchase and maintain expensive server hardware and Microsoft SQL Server licensing fees.

Although many of the expensive hardware and software components are eliminated with cloud hosting, there are still requirements to fully utilize Rapattoni Magic 10 via remote services. Satisfactory performance of Magic 10 and all of its functions may not be achieved if your hardware and software fail to meet the minimum requirements.

<b>Network card</b>	1 Gb/s	TCP/IP must be set as the primary network protocol.
<b>Monitor</b>	1280 x 1024 pixels	
<b>Internet connection – Bandwidth requirements for up to 5 workstations</b>	10 Mb/s down and 3 Mb/s up	Broadband is required. Each workstation must have direct access to the Internet.
<b>Operating Systems</b>	One of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Microsoft Windows 7 (32-bit or 64-bit)</li><li>• Microsoft Windows 8</li><li>• Mac OS X 10.11</li></ul>	Mac support is limited and Outlook® email integration is only available for Windows®
<b>Security</b>	Firewall Anti-virus software	Firewall and anti-virus software is included with most operating systems. Port 3389 (RDP) must be allowed in the Firewall.

## Mail Server Options

These mail server options apply only to email sent from within the *Magic 10* software, including email billing. Neither of these options takes the place of your organization's standard email services.

Email Options	Notes
<b>Option 1</b>	Rapattoni will host the mail server, and send emails with an "On behalf of" tag for your association email. All reply emails return to a single email address provided by your organization.
<b>Option 2</b>	You can use your existing mail server, natively. You will need to create an external relay to allow Rapattoni's IP address to send through your mail server.

Both solutions use the built-in email forms in *Magic 10* and integration with Outlook® is also available for Windows®.

## Software Compatibility

Software	Use	Notes
<b>Adobe Acrobat Reader</b>	To view and print files exported in PDF format	If a printer compatible with RDP printing is not available then the document will print to PDF.
<b>Microsoft Word</b>	To view, edit, and print files exported in .doc, .rtf, or .txt format	Other word processing or text editing software may be compatible.
<b>Microsoft Excel</b>	To view, edit, and print files exported in .xls or .csv format	Other spreadsheet software may be compatible.
<b>Accounting</b>	To export journal entry files into general ledger software capable of importing .xls or .csv format

<b>Encryption</b>	Encryption will be enabled for all available fields in <i>Magic 10</i>	
<b>SSL Certificate</b>	Option 1: Use Rapattoni's SSL certificate for the rapams.com domain.	This option will require that you change your IMS URL address to point to the customername.rapams.com address.
<b>SSL Certificate</b>	Option 2: Your organization can use its own SSL certificate branded with your domain name (e.g., ims.domain.com).	This option will require your organization to purchase/renew the SSL certificate and provide the necessary information to Rapattoni.

<b>Credit Card Readers</b>	Tracks 1 & 2 with no carriage return.
<b>Cash Drawer</b>	This item does NOT work with the Rapattoni hosted service.
<b>Receipt Printers</b>	This item does NOT work with the Rapattoni hosted service.
